THE RULES OF THE CHRISTIAN HUSBAND Eph. 5:18-33; I Peter 3:1-7

- I. The Husbands Attitude Toward His Wife and Family
 - A. He must earn His wife's Love and Respect vs.33
 - 1. To generate respect a man must first love (agapaō=sinless, selfless, sacrificial) himself vs.28. Balanced by our love of God Rom. 8:31
 - 2. A man must love his wife I Cor. 7:3

He must tell and show her - often and convincingly

- 3. Marriage is a sharing and giving experience Learn about her feelings and live with her in understand. I Peter 3:5-7
- B. He must earn his children's Love and Respect

If a man loves his wife as he should he will love his children and they will love him. He will demonstrate it:

- 1. By spending time with your children Eph. 6:2
- 2. By talking to them often Deut. 6:6-9

- 3. By being fair (equity)
- 4. By admitting mistakes, quickly and honestly
- 5. By taking family trips together
- C. He must guide them as they grow. Children watch their parents; Dad bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
