- 1. Love-Love of God, love of mate, love of child (children)
- 2. Godly Example Dad and Mom are God's role models.
- 3. Consistency In behavior, life, life, language, love
- 4. Discipline standards set, standards kept, standards enforced
- 5. Strong Father Positive Leadership

THESE FIVE QUALITIES ARE FOUND IN EMOTIONALLY HEALTHY CHILDREN!

GOD'S PURPOSE FOR FATHERS

There is no more important or responsible a position in our nation than that of a Godly Father!

- I. Many of the purposes (tasks) of a Father
 - A. To Provide and protect
 - 1. Abraham was "very rich in cattle, silver and gold Gen. 13:2
 - 2. Some can't provide due to uncontrollable circumstances
 - 3. Other's won't I Tim. 5:18 or waste their income on nonessentials
 - B. To Teach and train
 - 1. Spiritual food must be provided Deut. 6:7
 - 2. Intellectual Stimulus Luke 2:40, 52; Prov. 23:15-26
 - 3. Involve the children early in work
 - C. Disciplining
 - 1. Many otherwise fine fathers have failed in this aspect. Ex. - Eli, David, David, Samuel, Manoah
 - 2. Warnings Prov. 13:24; 19:18, 19; 23:13, 14; II; Eph. 6:4 abomination – putting into the mind by word, reproof, discipline and reprogramming of the Lord. II Tim. 3:16, 17
 - D. Loving
 - 1. All of the Above must be done in love.
 - 2. In I Cor. 13:4 & 7 substitute "Father" for "Charity"

 - 2. In Work Honest, Diligent, Dependable
 - 3. In Community Caring, Sharing, Compassionate
 - 4. In Church Not Hypocritical, Faithfulness, Tither, Consistent
 - B. Be Prayerful
 - 1. For Yourself
 - 2. For Family Member
 - 3. For Others Needs, Salvation, Health
 - C. Be Present Absentee Fathers are the Curse of Children
