LOVE IS: Caring and sharing

LOVE IS SHARING the best and most beautiful things in the world cannot be seen or touched but are felt in the heart.

LOVE IS CARING: Take time to understand and lend a gentle.

FRIENDSHIP is a special gift.

I. LOVE IS A COMMAND – John 13:34; 14:15; 15:12; I John 4:7-9

Love is a Choice to make, an emotion to feel.

A. Author of the Command – both Agape (choice) and Phileo (fondness)

B. Example of the Command – John 13:1-15; I John 4:16-21 by hearing, by helping, by healing

1. The Servants Job – to show a servants heart – Jesus had the servant's heart vs. 1-5

2. The Spiritual significances of Jesus and Peter exchange –
vs. 6-11; I John 1:7-10

3. The Lesson for us all vs. 12-17 – If the master serves then you to shall serve.
Read vs. 17 in conclusion – Happiness comes from serving.

A. Demonstrated by what we say. Titus 3:15; Eph. 4:15

B. Demonstrated by what we do – 15:13; I Thess.3:12; 4:9

To do it, to touch, embrace, listen, care, comfort, give

Gal. 5:13, 14

C. Demonstrated by how we react – Rom. 12:9,10; Phil. 1:9

Holy Kiss Luke 7:45; Rom. 16:16; I Cor. 16:20; II Cor. 13:12

I Thess. 5:26; I Peter 5:14; Embrace Acts 20:10, 37
