

Genesis 22:8 And Abraham said, My son, God will provide HIMSELF a lamb for a burnt offering: so they went both of them together. John 1:29 The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.

The Lamb is God HIMSELF

John 8:24 I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I AM HE, ye shall die in your sins. Cf. Ex.3:14

Throughout the New Testament, we see God providing HIMSELF for our eternal salvation.

Gal. 1:4 Who gave HIMSELF for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the will of God and our Father:

1Tim. 2:6 Who gave HIMSELF a ransom for all, to be testified in due time.

Titus 2:14 Who gave HIMSELF for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works. Cf. I Peter 2:9

Heb. 2:14 Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, He also HIMSELF likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;

Heb. 7:25 Wherefore He is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by Him, seeing He ever liveth to make intercession for them. 26 For such a high priest became us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and made higher than the heavens; 27 Who needeth not daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifice, first for his own sins, and then for the people's: for this He did once, when He offered up HIMSELF. 28 For the law maketh men high priests which have infirmity; but the word of the oath, which was since the law, maketh the Son, who is consecrated for evermore.

Heb. 9:24 For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, which are the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us: 25 Nor yet that He should offer HIMSELF often, as the high priest entereth into the holy place every year with blood of others; 26 For then must He often have suffered since the foundation of the world: but now once in the end of the world hath He appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of HIMSELF.

Eph. 2:20 And are built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ HIMSELF being the chief corner stone; I Pet. 2:6-8; Ps.118:22,23; Isa.8:14; 28:16
