Genesis 22:8 And Abraham said, My son, God will provide HIMSELF a lamb for a burnt offering: so they went both of them together. John 1:29 The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.

The Lamb is God HIMSELF

John 8:24 I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I AM HE, ye shall die in your sins. Cf. Ex.3:14

Thoughout the New Testament, we see God providing HIMSELF for our eternal salvation.

- Gal. 1:4 Who gave HIMSELF for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the will of God and our Father:
- 1Tim. 2:6 Who gave HIMSELF a ransom for all, to be testified in due time.
- Titus 2:14 Who gave HIMSELF for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works. Cf. I Peter 2:9
- Heb. 2:14 Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, He also HIMSELF likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;
- Heb. 7:25 Wherefore He is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by Him, seeing He ever liveth to make intercession for them. 26 For such an high priest became us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and made higher than the heavens; 27 Who needeth not daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifice, first for his own sins, and then for the people's: for this H did once, when He offered up HIMSELF. 28 For the law maketh men high priests which have infirmity; but the word of the oath, which was since the law, maketh the Son, who is consecrated for evermore.
- Heb. 9:24 For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, which are the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us: 25 Nor yet that He should offer HIMSELF often, as the high priest entereth into the holy place every year with blood of others; 26 For then must He often have suffered since the foundation of the world: but now once in the end of the world hath He appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of HIMSELF.
- Eph. 2:20 And are built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ HIMSELF being the chief corner stone; I Pet. 2:6-8; Ps.118:22,23; Isa.8:14; 28:16
