GOD WITH US or G-O-D W-I-T-H U-S

G - Grace (gift, Gospel): Ephesians 2:8-10

O - Offering: He was God's offering; now God asks us to be His: Romans 12:1

D - Dwelt: John 1:14 a

W - Word (Witness): Hebrews 4:12,13; 2 Timothy 3:16,17

I - Inheritance: Romans 8:16,17

T - Temple: The temple of God has changed addresses, from Jerusalem to the heart of man: 2 Corinthians 6:16

H - Holy (Holiness): 1 Peter 1:16

U - Unbelief: Romans 11:19-21; Mark 9:24

S - Savior: Luke 2:11

What's in a name? Acts 4:12. Everything, if it is the name that is above every name—the Name by which every man must be saved!

If God is "with us" shouldn't we introduce Him to those we encounter?

Let me suggest 10 things we can do:

- 1 Get to know God, up close and personal, then introduce others to Him!
- 2 Get to know people up close and personal, and then introduce them to Jesus!
- 3 Believe, He loves them and they can and will respond to Him.
- 4 Expect the Holy Spirit to accompany you.
- 5 Expect the Holy Spirit to empower you.
- 6 Pray (until something happens).
- 7 Start with little efforts . . . expect great results!
- 8 Be Patient and Persevere—in His time!
- 9 Invite, Invite, invite . . . sacrifice, sacrifice, and sacrifice!
- 10 Go home with peace of mind and spirit!
