It Revealed the Purpose of Christ Matt. 21:1-11 cf. Luke 1:30-33

To present Himself as the promised and legitimate King of the Jews – Jer. 23:5; John 1:11; Zechariah 9:9

"It represents the making of a formal, public, open, almost official claim to being the King prophesied in Zechariah 9." – Leon Morris; <u>The Cross in the New Testament</u>

It Revealed the Perverseness of Man

Mark 11:8-10 cf. Mark 15:12-15 Mark 7:14-23 Matt. 12:33-37 Matt. 15:8

It Revealed the Plan of God

Mark 10:32-34 cf. Acts 2:22-24

Acts 4:26-28 cf. Eph. 1:3-10

Son of David-Royal Title of Lord Jesus – Messianic promise of a coming glorious reign and Kingdom of Righteousness which was promised to Israel at the Coming of the Messiah. (Isa. 9:6,7; II Sam. 7:8,11,13,16; I Tim. 1:17 also Psa. 89; Jer. 23:5,6; Rev. 19:16; and 1:4-7)

HE IS ETERNAL - I Tim 1:17a

- He is without beginning or ending (Psa. 102:24-27; Deut. 33:27)

HE IS IMMORTAL - I Tim 1:17b

- Life - without deterioration or decay; uncorrupted. I.e. Life without end, and unceasing and unblemished. (Rom. 2:7)

HE IS INVISIBLE - I Tim 1:17c

- Not capable of being seen. (Rom. 1:20; Col. 1:15,16; I Tim. 1:17; Heb. 11:27)

HE IS OMNI-SAPIENT - I Tim 1:17d

- The all-wise God. He can make the choice of the highest end. He can choose the best way to attain the highest end. (Rom. 11:33, 34; see Rom. 16:27; I Cor. 2:7; Eph. 1:8; 3:10-12)

Conclusion: We are to give Him glory and honor.
