A practical and hospitable FAITH was on display in this home.

This Shunammite woman was very generous and very hospitable.

You can't take it with you. (hospitality under the oaks of Mamre)

She sought the approval of her husband.

Let us Bless the Guest!

Believers should make hospitality a part of their lifestyle.

An angel is a messenger of God

Children are a gift from God, and the Shunammite was content without them.

Born once II Kings 4:11-17

Indirectly, Elisha helped them conceive. (A Capable God under the oaks of Mamre)

The Lord often blesses us in surprising ways, and at surprising times.

God knows our hearts, and REALLY cares about our secret frustrations.

The Shunammites did not seek this out, they did not ask for this child to be born.

Tragedy II Kings 4:18-21

This death was literal and living in a sinful world that is a harsh reality.

The husband is a background figure in the story

This is not an ideal situation for a child.

She went the extra mile II Kings 4:22-26

She was prepared to travel fifteen miles on the back of a donkey!

The story of Dimitri Mendeleev 1848. She traveled 1753 miles

The Wesley's mother was a mother prepared to go the extra mile
