II Grace given to a slave Genesis 39:4 Joseph found grace in Potiphar's eyes

 A he was a successful man

 B the LORD was with Him

III Grace to a faithful servant Genesis 50:4 Joseph found grace in Pharaoh's eyes

 A For faithfulness in service

IV Grace to know God Exodus 33:12-17 Moses finds grace before God

 A God knew Him by name

 B My presence will go with you and I will give you rest

V Other instances of Grace

 A. A Precious stone Proverbs 17:8

 B. A Precious Woman Esther 2:17 Esther found grace in the sight of the king

The New Testament word is *Charis*. It focuses on the provision of salvation. Charis 5485
