

## **Luke 24 It was necessary!**

### **I DON'T NEED SHOES; I NEED THE RESURRECTION!**

Children have a different idea of needs than Jesus does.

I need my cell phone, I need those basketball shoes, I need a souvenir.

**Problem #1** v 3-4 They did not find the body... They were perplexed

### **I Remember how He spoke to you .....in Galilee.** v 5-7

New Testament started legally on Resurrection morning, and practically on then day of Pentecost.

Jesus said it had to happen. Luke 9:22 & Luke 18:31-33

He came back to solidify the gift of salvation by the blood. Hebrews 9:11-17

**Problem #2** v 21 We were hoping that it was He who was going to redeem Israel. Indeed besides all today is the third day.

### **II Out not the Christ to have suffered these things and to enter into His glory?** v 26

David prophetically speaks of Christ death and resurrection Psalm 16:8-11

Psalm 16 explained by Peter. Death could not hold Him! Acts 2:22-33

**Problem #3** The disciples have lots of problems.

v12 Peter departed ... Marveled to himself

v 37 They were terrified and frightened.

v 41 while they still did not believe for joy, and marveled

### **III Thus it was necessary for Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead the third day.** v46

They will look on Me whom they pierced. Zechariah 12:10

We could also talk of Job 19 Psalm 22 Isaiah 53 Jonah Passover and many other OT foreshadowing's, but...

He is coming again Revelation 1:7

Response: I don't need new, shoes I need the resurrection! Consider Acts 2 Hebrews 9 and Revelation 1

- I Repentance – surrender to God as sovereign , sorrow and regret for sins with intentions of a complete change of direction toward God. Stop turn around and Run to Christ!
- II Remission of sins – the act of delivering from the punishment, power, and presence of sins through the blood of Jesus Christ!
- III For a witness
- IV The Coming Holy Spirit
